

Restricted access area

Unauthorised entry prohibited

Seabird and turtle nesting

Entry to Aplin and Milman islets, Yamarrinh Wachangan Islands (Denman Group) National Park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal land)—refer to map—is prohibited without a permit or written approval.

Nesting seabirds are easily startled and will leave their nests if disturbed. Eggs and chicks are then vulnerable to heat, cold and predators, and can die quickly.

Nesting turtles are easily disturbed by light, noises and movement. When disturbed they will return to the water without laying their eggs. Turtle hatchlings are disorientated by light and are then vulnerable to predators.

Contravention of a requirement of this notice is an offence against the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*.

Penalties apply. Maximum penalty: 120 penalty units.
