

Restricted Access Area

Unauthorised entry prohibited

Cultural heritage protection



Visitors to Kookaburra Cave must remain on the formed track, steps or boardwalk and behind the handrail.

To protect fragile rock art, a restricted access area has been declared on each side of the formed track, steps and boardwalk within the fenced area, as shown on the map.

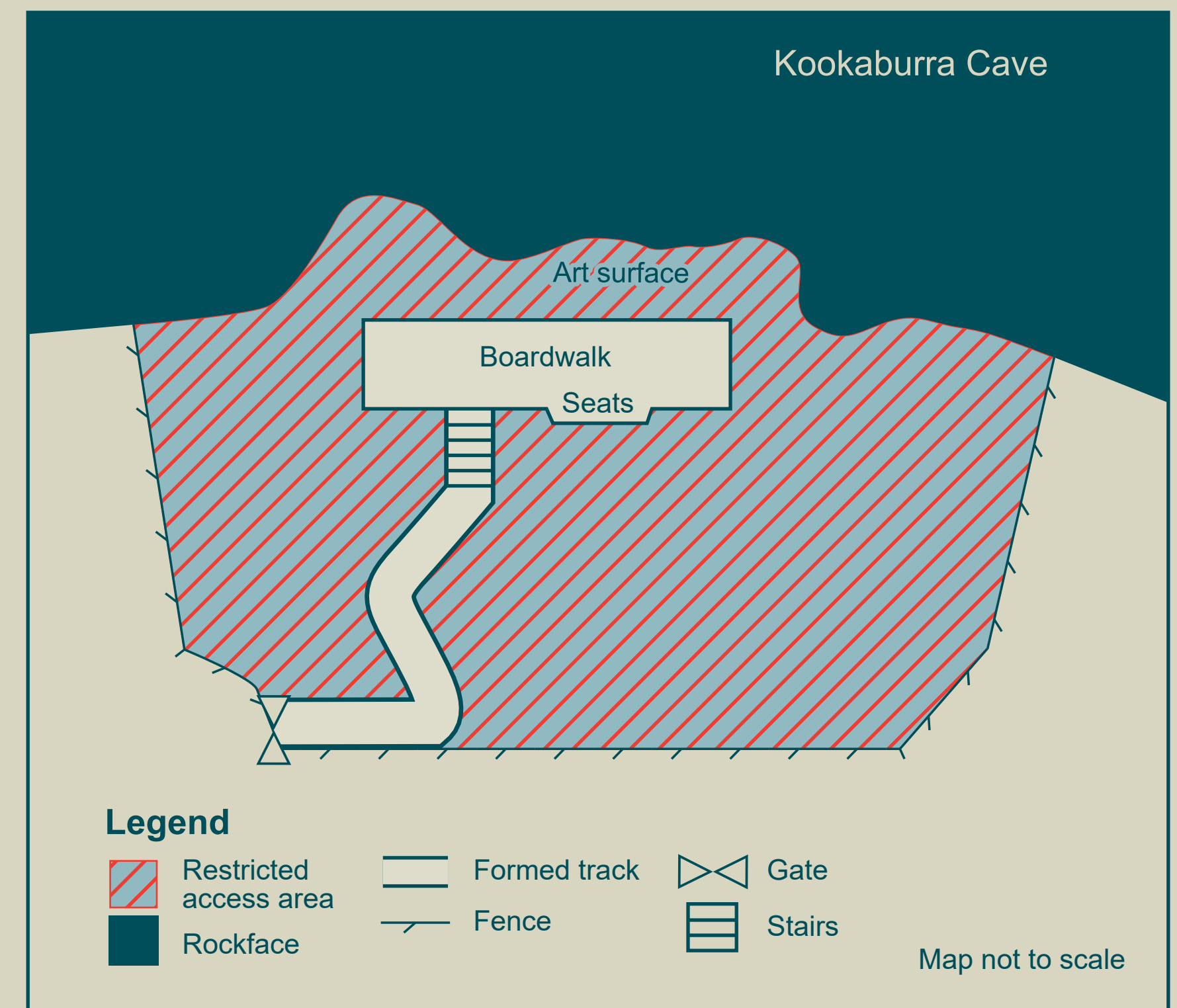
Entry to the restricted access area is prohibited without a permit or written approval.

Contravention of a requirement of this notice is an offence against the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*.

Penalties apply. Maximum penalty: 120 penalty units.

Visitors are reminded that it is a serious offence against the *Nature Conservation Act 1992* to interfere with a cultural resource, such as Aboriginal rock art, anywhere in a protected area.

Maximum penalty: 3000 penalty units.
