

Restricted Access Area

Unauthorised entry prohibited

Cultural heritage protection



Visitors to The Tombs must remain behind the barrier fence.

To protect fragile rock art, a restricted access area has been declared within the fenced area, as shown on the map.

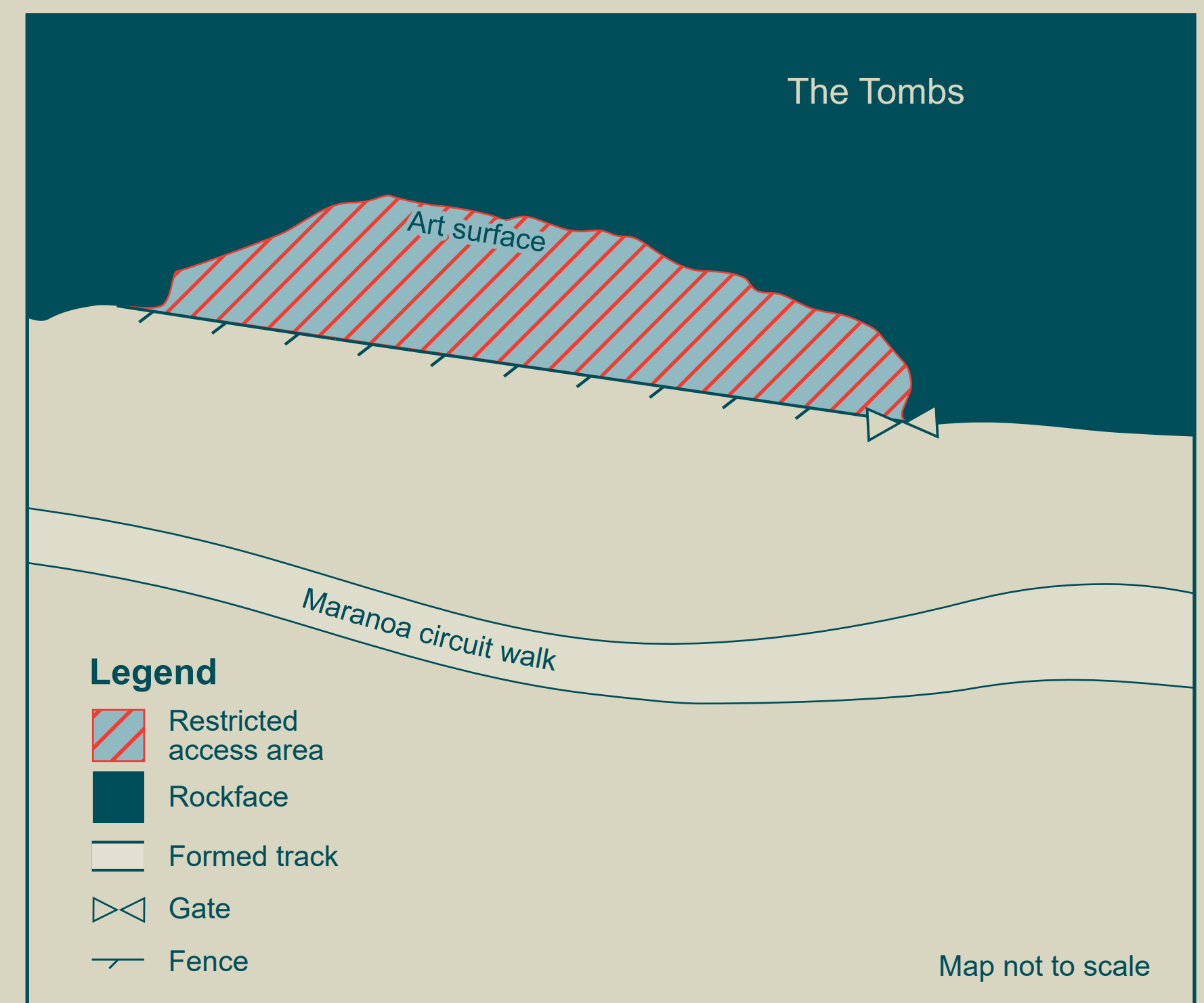
Entry to the restricted access area is prohibited without a permit or written approval.

Contravention of a requirement of this notice is an offence against the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*.

Penalties apply. Maximum penalty: 120 penalty units.

Visitors are reminded that it is a serious offence against the *Nature Conservation Act 1992* to interfere with a cultural resource, such as Aboriginal rock art, anywhere in a protected area.

Maximum penalty: 3000 penalty units.
