

Restricted access area

Unauthorised entry prohibited

Protection of cultural resources



Entry to Clack Island (Ngurromo), Flinders Group National Park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal land)—refer to map—is prohibited without a permit or written approval.

The restriction enables the Flinders Islands People and Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service to protect and manage the cultural values of the area.

A person, other than an acknowledged Flinders Islands Person, must not enter or remain in the restricted access area shown on the map without a permit or written approval.

Contravention of a requirement of this notice is an offence against the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*.

Penalties apply. Maximum penalty: 120 penalty units.
